

Oh-So-Easy Crocheted Washing-Up Cloths

(single crochet washcloths or dishrags or whatever, for the beginner or the lazy, lol) Single crochet with a double crochet border



hook used: k/10.5/6.5mm
yarn used: cotton worsted

SC = single crochet
DC = double crochet

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Row 1: Chain 20 (or more, if you want a larger cloth, mine were about 7.5" across with the border) plus 2 to turn.

Turn.

Row 2 and all others: In 3rd stitch in loop (the one that was #20), start and single crochet across. Chain 2 at end of row.

Turn.

Continue to sc 20 stitches per row until piece is approximately square.

Without breaking yarn, start double crocheting around piece, at each corner stitch, dc three times into the loop. When you get back to the place you started the border, do one sc and then cut yarn and tie off and fasten in all ends.
